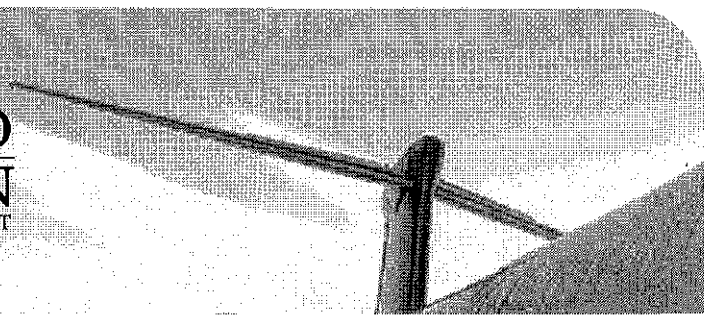

Expected Action: General Aviation Operators will no longer be required to book arrival or departure reservations for the period 1500-1959 Local Sunday through Friday.

Background and Impact:

As published in the Canada Flight Supplement, General Aviation Operators have been required to make arrival and departure reservations at Toronto Pearson during the daytime peak hours of 1500 to 1959 Local, Sunday through Friday. This requirement was established in an effort to mitigate congestion issues.

A recent analysis has concluded that Toronto Pearson's current capacity is such that this action is not necessary at this time. The GTAA has therefore established a moratorium on the requirement for GA operators to file a reservation for peak periods for one year. At that time, the situation will be reassessed.

Please note that this change does not apply to the restricted hours (0030-0629L). Operators shall continue to request permission to arrive and/or depart during these hours by contacting the GTAA at 416-776-3480 or 1-800-267-SLOT (7568).
