



**General Aviation Privacy
Aircraft Situation Display-to-Industry**

Vendor Code of Conduct

The National Business Aviation Association (NBAA) maintains this code of conduct on behalf of the general aviation community to express concerns with regard to protecting their security and privacy when engaging in IFR operations. Aircraft Situation Display-to-Industry (ASDI) vendors agree to voluntarily abide by the following guidelines:

1. ASDI Vendors are those companies that receive the ASD feed directly from the VOLPE Center or receive the ASDI data indirectly from a company that receives the direct data feed from the VOLPE Center.
2. ASDI Vendors acknowledge that the ASDI information is intended to be used for improving flight management and to increase the safety and efficiency of aviation operations.
3. On a monthly basis, ASDI vendors will receive an electronic list from NBAA via email. This list represents those aircraft for which owners have requested security and privacy protection in both a real time and historical basis. The list will include all aircraft registration numbers, call signs, or flight numbers currently included in the BARR program. Only aircraft included in the monthly list shall be considered under the provisions of this Vendor Code of Conduct.
4. Upon receipt of the monthly BARR list, ASDI vendors agree to update their respective systems within FIVE business days.
5. ASDI vendors must provide NBAA, an e-mail address to which the monthly BARR update is sent. To insure redundancy ASDI vendors may submit up to three e-mail addresses to receive the BARR list.
6. ASDI vendors agree to not display, in real time flight tracking products and/or any historical databases, the following ASDI data associated with all aircraft participating in the BARR program.
 - Aircraft registration number, call sign, or flight number
 - Aircraft manufacturer and model designationsThe definition of historical includes any data covering the period starting with the date the aircraft was added to the BARR program through the period in which the aircraft was removed from the BARR program.
7. ASDI Vendors may enter into agreements with individual aircraft owners, operators, or designees, which will allow the selective release of ASDI data generally restricted by the BARR program while maintaining the BARR data restrictions for the general public.

8. Vendors will ensure that reasonable steps are taken to prevent disclosure of information associated with aircraft contained in the BARR database. The signatory below is responsible for informing any “downstream” recipient of the ASDI feed of the requirement to sign and return a copy of this VCC to NBAA.
