HOW CAN I SUPPORT THE NBAA-PAC?

By granting NBAA what is called “prior approval,” we will have the opportunity to educate your employees about the importance of the NBAA-PAC.

WHAT IS PRIOR APPROVAL?

The NBAA-PAC must receive prior written permission to request donations from NBAA Member Company managerial employees. Each year, thousands of companies around the country grant prior approval to trade association PACs to contact their employees.

WOULD MY COMPANY'S EMPLOYEES REALLY MAKE A DIFFERENCE?

Yes! NBAA-PAC funds are appreciated, and by combining Member Company employee donations with other NBAA-PAC funds, our collective voice is much more efficient and effective in representing our industry to elected officials.

WHY GIVE PRIOR APPROVAL?

- Every individual who works at an NBAA Member Company is impacted by the state of the general aviation industry.
- Prior approval allows the NBAA-PAC to take the place of a PAC for smaller Members that do not have their own PACs.
- Prior approval is a key mechanism that allows trade association PACs to be successful.
- NBAA is asking you – our Members – to help protect the interests of the business aviation community. This could be one of the best decisions you ever make.

HOW DO I GIVE PRIOR APPROVAL?

Federal law requires the NBAA-PAC to obtain authorization from NBAA Member Companies before soliciting the company’s executive and administrative personnel, stockholders and their families. Only an authorized representative of the Member Company may grant prior approval for solicitations. Further, a Member Company may not allow solicitations by the NBAA-PAC if the company has authorized solicitations by another trade association PAC within the same calendar year.
